- to report a potential hazard or incident on the school site, please contact the office on 03 5862 1088.
- for parent payments, please contact the office on 03 5862 1088.
- for all other enquiries, please contact our Office on 03 5862 1088.

School staff will do our best to respond to general queries as soon as possible and ask that you allow us up to 2 working days to provide you with a detailed response. We will endeavour to respond to urgent matters within 24 hours where possible.
