UNIFORM AND DRESS CODE POLICY

RATIONALE

Numurkah Secondary School Council has made the decision that students will wear correct school uniform during school time and on designated school activities, such as excursions. A uniform reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, promotes safety through enhancing identification of NSC students, and assists in developing pride in representing their school. Issues of equality, health and safety, and expense are also factors that contribute to the decision to have a school uniform.

AIMS

- To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.
- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To provide durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.
- To maintain and enhance the positive image and identity of the school in the community.

IMPLEMENTATION:

- The Numurkah Secondary College uniform provides choice for the students, allows for students to safely engage in the many varied school activities, and caters for the financial constraints of families.
- The school uniform requirements (attached), including details of uniform items and cost, will be published in the newsletter at the start of each year.
- The school uniform is available from Sport First, 103 Melville Street, Numurkah. The NSC Spray Jacket will be available for purchase from the General Office.
- The School Uniform requirement applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions.
- Summer and winter uniforms, as well as sports uniforms are prescribed, and are required to be worn at the appropriate times of year.
- Body piercings may be required to be removed at the discretion of the NSC Leadership Team.

Teachers will:

- Enforce the College Uniform Policy by requesting a signed and dated note from a student regarding the item which is not part of school uniform, and then uploading this information to Compass.
- Pass on to Year Level Leader/ Assistant Principal concerns about a student who is consistently wearing non-uniform items, so that contact can be made with the family.
- Year Level Leaders and the Wellbeing Team will provide support for families having difficulty providing correct uniform. This may involve using the College uniform supply for a short loan period, or financial support for purchasing a uniform.

Students will:

- Understand and be familiar with the College Uniform Policy.
- Wear correct school uniform during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions.
- Provide a written note, signed and dated by their parents or guardians, explaining the reason for incorrect uniform.

Parents are requested to:

- Become familiar with the College Uniform Policy and ensure their child has, and wears, the appropriate items.
- Contact the College if there is any doubt as to what the 'required school uniform' is.
- Provide a written note, signed and dated if for any reason a student is unable to wear part of the required uniform.

IMPLEMENTATION:

School Uniform

All students at Numurkah Secondary College are expected to dress in full school uniform every day.

We ask parents to support us by ensuring that your child is dressed in school uniform, including the correct footwear, at all times. On the rare occasion when this is not possible, students are expected to bring a signed note from home.
